- c. Amit and Sara ran to the bus stop.

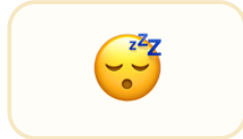
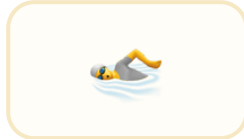
2 Write is, am or are in each blank
